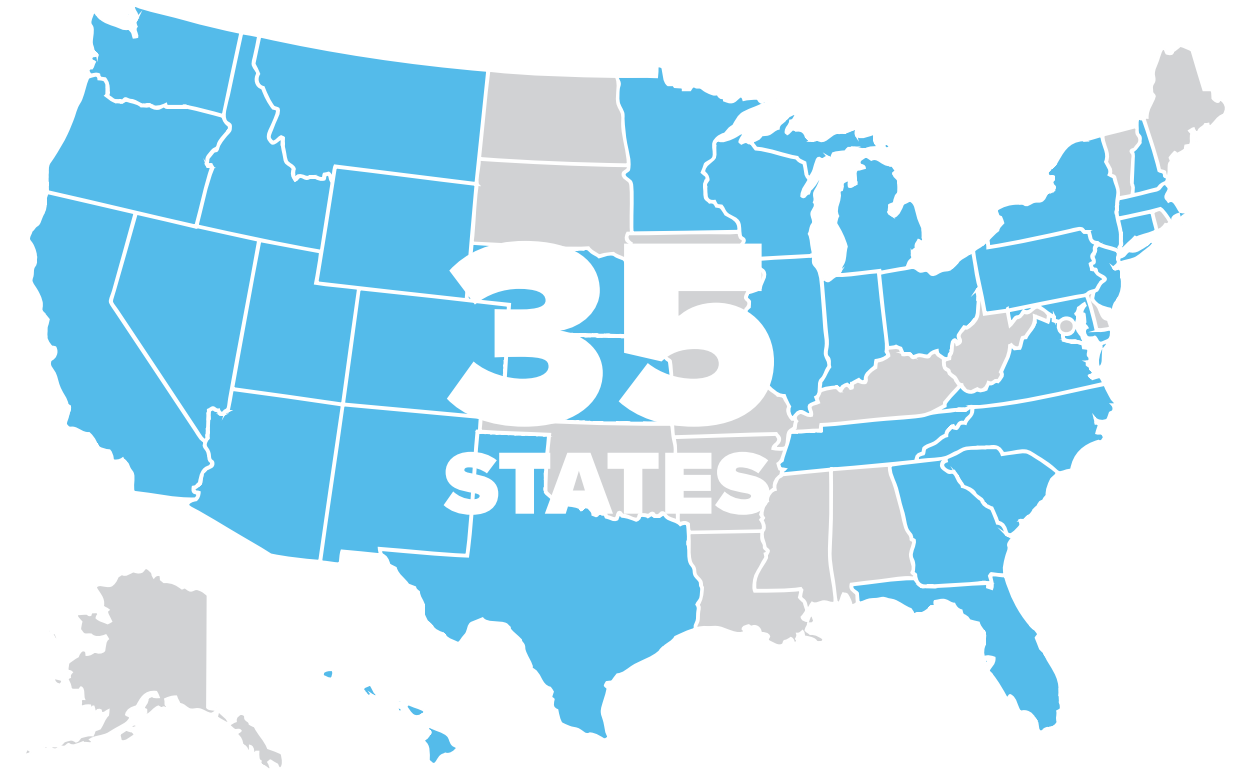
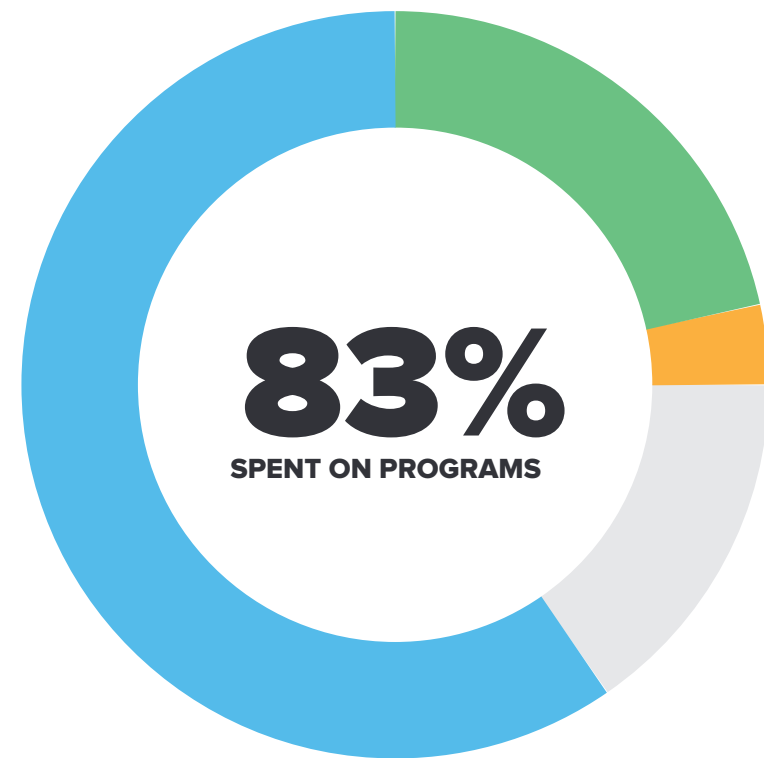


PARKOUR VISIONS 2018

EMBRACING CHALLENGE, MAKING IMPACT



BREAKING BOUNDARIES

In 2018, Parkour Visions broke boundaries -- delivering programs, designwork, events, and community initiatives that directly impacted youth and adult practitioners, coaches, business owners, and enthusiasts from over 30 Seattle neighborhoods, 35 states, and 5 countries.

EDUCATION

Commitment to providing high quality learning experiences for students of all ages and dimensions of diversity has been a foundation of the Parkour Visions way since we first started.

90% of our programming in 2018 was new--we forged major partnerships with King County, the City of Seattle Parks, Seattle Public Schools, and the Associated Recreation Council. We ran classes in almost two dozen neighborhoods, ran our very first STEAM+(M)ovement camps, and began building class communities around training approaches--low impact, power, and games. A generous grant has fueled a free afterschool program for at-risk youth in South Seattle.

Children as young as 7 and adults into their early 60s connected with PKV--with direct impact on practitioners in 35 states, 7 countries, and across the greater Seattle region.



From promoting environmental stewardship to supporting leadership development

PKV helped facilitate 4 major events including the international Art of Retreat parkour conference (which directly reached 95 leaders and coaches from 25 states and 4 countries), as well as the Sebastian Foucan Tour, connecting american cities with to one of the historical figures in parkour.

In May we relaunched monthly womens meetups and beginner jams, and almost every week of the year offered a free class open to the public.
